

What is AIMSweb?

At certain times during the school year, your child will be given a paper/pencil assessment called AIMSweb. Administered in fall, winter and spring, this assessment is focused in the areas of math and reading. Results will be used to track student growth in these subject areas and determine any areas of needed improvement. Results will be shared with parents during conferences in November.



MARIA MONTESSORI- OUR HISTORY

Maria was an Italian physician who studied how children learned through detailed observation. Over a period of years she designed materials for children in a prepared environment in which children could discover a natural desire to learn. By providing children with a stimulating environment, the children could grow as independent, self motivated learners.

MONTESSORI MATERIAL HIGHLIGHT- GOLDEN BEADS

One of the most frequently seen materials in kindergarten and 6-9 classrooms is the golden beads work. This consists of single units, ten bars, hundred squares and thousand cubes. It is used from introductory concepts such as counting and place value, then progressing over time into addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. These beads are tactile, attractive and easy to understand.
