-Check out local events like festivals, museums, nature centers and parks. Talk about what you see and things you learn as you go!

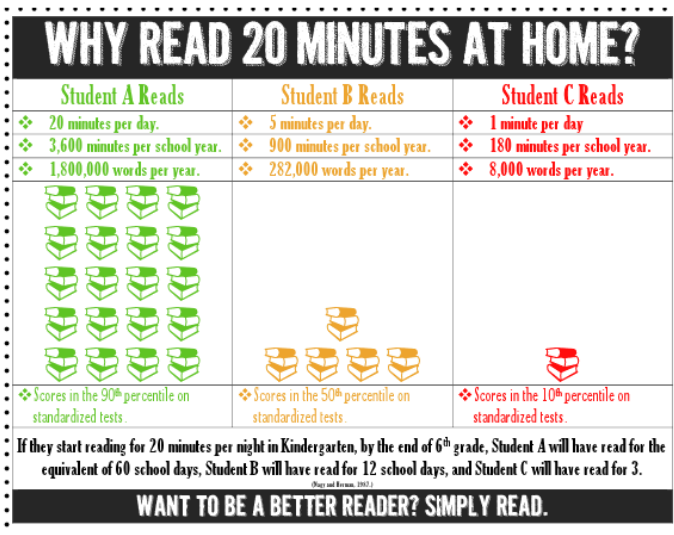


CALLING ALL READERS!!
